Access by train

Take Shinagawa East gate and walk towards the Konan Exit. The Shinagawa station Konan Exit connects directly to the Shinagawa Intercity and it's on the same floor (the second floor) of the clinic. Shinagawa East Clinic provides vaccinations to adults as re-vaccination prior to working and traveling foreign countries, studying abroad, etc. Staff members actively attend international meetings and are educated with new information.

This clinic also offers consultation of proper vaccinations (type of vaccine, timing), and pre- and post-trip medical check-up. We also issue various certificates written in English. If you have concerns about your health during the trip, we can write necessary information for the medical authorities.

Vaccination is important step to protect you from getting sickness by the infectious diseases as well as to minimize spreading the disease to others. You should tell friends or relatives about your trip and information for possible emergencies to have trip with a peace of mind.

Vaccines

- You should receive appropriate vaccines according to the destination, purpose of the trip, seasons, and type of activities. We provide the updated information for vaccines. Some vaccines take certain time to build up a strong immunity. You should call us well in advance to avoid incomplete immunity build-up.

Preparation

- Vaccination:
We issue a WHO vaccination certificate
- Pre-travel counseling regarding living condition, local health issues
- Certifications written in English to apply for school or visa
- Prescribe medications for trip
- Pre-trip and post-trip medical checkup
- HIV test (one day determination)
- Tests for antibodies:
Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Japanese encephalitis, Rubella, Measles, Mumps, Chicken pox etc.

Confirmation

- If you don't feel well, you should immediately report to your doctor and mention about the trip, location, schedule, etc. You may get sickness during the trip, but some infectious diseases have a long incubation period. Therefore you may become sick long time after you completed the trip. You should call doctor and get an advice.
- We can refer you to the following hospital specializing infectious diseases,
The Institute of Medical Science, The University of Tokyo
- Corporate workers staying in foreign countries for long period are advised to receive medical check-up during temporary coming home, or after completion of the duties.
